FORUM REPORT THAT TOOK PLACE IN MBARARA ARCHDIOCESE UGANDA:

The event took place in Mbarara ArchDiocese at Kyabirikwa Mother House a well recognized and popular place in the whole country for being a home for Sister of Our Lady of Good Counsel.

The event started on 13th /september-14th/September 2025. The participants reported Saturday morning from different locations/Dioceses across the country. Among the Dioceses where they came from include, Mbarara ArchDiocese, Kampala ArchDiocese, Fort Portal Diocese, Kasese Diocese, Kabale Diocese and Goma Diocese in Congo.

Among the participants who attended the forum were the priests, Sisters from different Congregations, The Archbishop Beinomugisha Lambert, the Parish Coordinators, Catechists, Youth, men, women from all the mentioned areas and also representatives from ARU and Joint Effort for Future Uganda.

In total 2041 participants attended the forum from 46 Parishes that make five Dioceses mentioned above.



The reception team took an initiative to register all the participants by noting their details like contact numbers for those who had them among others.

The theme was "who is my Neighbour"? This was intended to create awareness in regard to works of mercy and to encourage the participants to live in harmony as Brothers and Sisters in order to share on the gift of salvation.

During the Forum different facilitators were brought on Board to take through the participants in different sessions at different intervals.

The first session was Walk in Mercy, Live in Grace (Luke 6:36). The facilitator Sister Kasingye Secunda encouraged participants to be merciful as their Father who is Merciful in order to live in harmony and peace.

The Participants were also taken through the session by Brother Charles on Forgiveness in connection to mercy. Participants were given light on the importance of forgiveness and encouraged all to always forgive one another.

The Participants were also taken through the third session which was about mercy is inclusive and tends to expand in a way that has No limit (Gods Mercy is always in Action. This session gave a clear picture to participants that mercy is none segregative and we should be merciful to all at any time not to only people we know and we are close to but to treat all as Brothers and Sisters.

The participants were also taken through the forth session on how to Run a sustainable Business to Foster the Works of Mercy by Dr.Wilbroad. Participants were given key tips on how to start and manage Businesses while fostering the works of mercy.

In addition, the participants were also taken through Sinodality in relation to the works of mercy by Rev. Father Alex.

The first day ended with a mass led by Rev.Fr. Vincent who welcomed and thanked all participants for turning in big numbers for the forum and urged them to learn, master the content given to them to practise it to fellow citizens.

All the participants who attended the forum were given Lunch and supper irrespective of where they were coming from and they were very happy for the care and Love.

After supper the participants were taken through Praise, worship and Deliverance session from 9:00pm up to midnight and all were given a closing prayer for guidance and protection throughout the night.

During the second day(Sunday) the first session was on the importance of Mercy as a christian. The facilitator urged participants to be merciful all the time to people around them and the ones they live with and to live a brotherly life not life full of jealousy and quarrels

Another session was on different perspectives to the understanding of neighbour and how we can become servants to the needy in our communities. The facilitator gave very many instances in regard to understanding of neighbour and what we ought to do as Christians to serve the needy in our community to give them hope and trust in our Creator.

The archbishop was pleased and expressed his gratitude for all that is being done for the works of mercy. We believe that it would be important for the establishment of an office for the works of mercy in the diocese that Luigi write directly to the archbishop and explain the role that this office will play.

After the session, a mass was led by His Grace Beinomugisha Lambert and a team of priests and Sisters.
