As Joint Effort for Future Uganda, we are very happy and pleased to share with you that we have sustained the Works of Mercy both Spiritual and Corporal and there is a great impact already created and the community members, stakeholders and religious leaders are impressed.

Over 200 people have been reached on a monthly basis, through counselling Sessions, promoting the idea of forgiveness and reconciliation, Instructing the Ignorant, comforting the afflicted, encouraging them to be patient especially those in difficult situations, to pray for the living and the dead. Material support has been extended to the neediest 20 community members with food and clothing's.

Across the rural District of Kamwenge in Uganda, 1 in 3 people has spiritual and support need that affects their mental health and wellbeing, Our program ensures that these communities are reached through home visitation and group-based support meetings. With support Joint Effort for Future Uganda is targeting to reach 20,000 people by 2028.
